MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR MEMBERSHIP

Eligibility: Any corporation or sole proprietorship shall be eligible for Membership in the Association, provided it:

- (1) Processes expanded polystyrene materials for sale in North America; or
- (2) Manufactures expanded polystyrene feedstock materials or processing equipment (excluding tools and molds) for the EPS industry in North America.

EPS Processor

Any EPS processor within the NAFTA region that produces expanded polystyrene (EPS) products for commercial use.

Raw Material Supplier

Any individual, partnership, joint venture, corporation, division, or other unit of a corporation that, as any portion of its business, manufactures, sells, resells, or distributes, or as a principal, causes to be manufactured or distributed, EPS-type plastic resin sold or distributed in NAFTA countries, U.S. territories or possessions. To qualify, an applicant must have been, itself, or through a predecessor in interest, engaged in such manufacturing, selling, reselling or distribution activity for at least one year. "EPS-type plastic resin" is any expandable plastic resin pellets, beads or powder composed principally of polystyrene that can be expanded or molded. Those manufacturers engaged in the production of both EPS molded products AND EPS-type plastic resin shall be determined based on the larger percentage of production for either function. Resin production for captive use by the manufacturer is deemed exempt if molding consumption is >51% of the company's annual production.

Equipment Supplier

Any manufacturer or distributor of machinery for processing expandable polystyrene for use by EPS processors in North America.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

Eligibility: Any corporation or sole proprietorship shall be eligible for Associate Membership provided it does not qualify for membership as a Regular Member of the Association.

EPS Fabricator

Any manufacturer that fabricates expanded polystyrene for building insulation, packaging, manufacturing components or other end-use applications.

EPS Manufacturing & Product Support

Any manufacturer that produces tools and/or molds, additives or other supply chain support for expanded polystyrene production for use by the EPS industry in North America.

Recycling Business

Any manufacturer who converts post-consumer or post-industrial polystyrene into resin pellet/flake or feedstock and/or a finished plastic product.

EPS Building System Manufacturer

Any manufacturer of Insulating Concrete Forms (ICFs), Structural Insulating Panels (SIPs) or other similar systems that utilize EPS as a primary material component.

AFFILIATE MEMBERS

Any organization or individual which has a primary interest in the expandable polystyrene industry and who does not qualify for membership in the Association under any of the aforementioned classes may be eligible to become an affiliate member under the terms and conditions set forth or as may be determined by the Board of Directors. Affiliate membership may be offered to retailers, building professionals and others with a direct commercial interest in the advancement of the EPS industry. ***Additional application procedures and membership criteria shall apply to those businesses whose primary activity is pertaining to licensing partnerships or similar business entities representing expanded polystyrene (EPS) products, systems, technologies and branding initiatives.***

AUXILIARY MEMBERS

Any organization or individual with a professional interest in supporting the ongoing use and advancement of expanded polystyrene applications and who does not qualify for membership in the Association under any of the aforementioned classes is eligible to become an auxiliary member.

MEMBERSHIP TERMS

Membership encompasses a period of one year from January 1 to December 31. Members joining throughout the course of the year will be assessed a pro-rated monthly fee beginning on the first day of the succeeding calendar month. Eligible members in good standing will receive all publications produced by the Association with restrictions to reproduce and distribute to others; may attend all regular meetings conducted by the Association; may participate in any activities organized by the Association including committee and special task force projects; and may pay reduced rates for literature orders and registration fees for meeting attendance.
